

POOL NEWS

The pool remains our community's most utilized amenity, and survey results showed strong support for resurfacing the pool.

Many members have asked when the pool was last replastered. We recently located records confirming the pool was renovated in 2002. This highlights the pool's longevity and how well it has served our community over the years. As expected, no warranty remains on the existing plaster surface.

The Board is currently obtaining proposals for a full pool replaster from several established pool contractors, including South Texas Custom Pools, Cody Pools, and Keith Zars Pools. We also have a proposal previously received from Gary Pools that will be considered as part of the evaluation process.

As suggested by members at the Annual Meeting, three residents have volunteered to provide additional oversight and community input throughout this project. These individuals serve as community volunteers and are not members of the Board. We appreciate their willingness to contribute their time and expertise and look forward to sharing updates as the project moves forward!

A quick reminder that the pool will be closed Mondays during the summer season for regular upkeep and maintenance. We currently plan to keep the pool open until October 31st, subject to adjustment for the resurfacing project.
